The **City of Daingerfield, Texas**, is requesting quotes from qualified vendors through approved **cooperative purchasing programs** (BuyBoard, HGACBuy, Sourcewell, TIPS, or equivalent) for **one (1) new Fire Truck** meeting or exceeding the following minimum specifications. Vendors must reference their **cooperative contract number** in their quote.

Minimum Specifications

- **Chassis:** Freightliner preferred or comparable
- **Cab:** Single cab with bench seat
- **Engine:** Cummins diesel engine (or equivalent)
- **Transmission:** Allison automatic transmission (or equivalent)
- **Pump:** PTO-driven fire pump, minimum 750 GPM with pump and roll and Q2B Siren
- **Foam System:** Scotty foam system or similar
- **Water Tank:** Minimum 1,000-gallon capacity
- **Rear Reel:** 150 ft. lightweight 1" line with Hen Nozzle
- **Cross Lay:** One (1) 1½" cross lay with 200 ft. of hose
- **Lighting:**
 - All emergency lighting LED
 - Left, right, and rear scene lighting (LED)
 - LED light bar with integrated directional light
- **Siren:** 100-watt siren with speaker
- **Compartments:**
 - Multiple exterior compartments with LED interior lighting
 - One compartment with MSA G2 SCBA holder brackets
 - Storage for two (2) additional SCBA bottles
- **Console:** Custom console for lights, siren, and radio controls, with charging ports for cell phones and tablets





- **Front Bumper:** 1½" hose connection with hose storage
- **Freight, delivery, and setup** included in the price
